QUITO, THE CENTER OF THE WORLD, GALAPAGOS ISLANDS CRUISE & HISTORIC GUAYAQUIL

DAY 1 • Arrive in Quito Airport assistance and welcome. Leisure day.

DAY 2 • Departure for Tour Quito and Center of the World @ Visit downtown and the colonial quarter (a UNESCO World Heritage Site). See Independence Plaza, flanked by the Cathedral, the Presidential Palace, the Municipal Building and the Archbishop's Palace. Visit the temple of La Compañía de Jesús and the Monastery of San Francisco. Stand with a foot on each hemisphere at the Equatorial Monument – the exact middle of the world. Visit the Ethnographic Museum and a colonial-style town. Tour panoramic Quito by night. Twinkling lights cover the valley as you enjoy dinner at one of the finest restaurants in the city.



that is now an important nesting area for the east Pacific green sea turtle. Enjoy a glorious white beach with several lagoons which are the feeding grounds of various wading birds, from stilts to flamingos. Get acquainted with snorkelling gear and techniques.

DAY 4 • Buccaneer Cove (James Island) @ Enjoy a coastal exploration and learn the history of Santiago Island, its whalers, pirates and conservation projects. See marine birds, sea lions, and inter-tidal organisms. Enjoy fantastic natural formations and an impressive natural cave. A great site for snorkelling too! • Puerto Egas (James Island) @ See land and marine birds. At low tide, marine iguanas graze upon algae beds and there is a colony of fur-sea lions. Snorkel and swim.

DAY 5 • Rábida Island (Jervis) @ Share the beach with a large colony of sea lions, iguanas, mockingbirds, warblers and Darwin's finches. Close by is a salt pond where greater flamingos migrate. Snorkel to view underwater species and landscapes, or enjoy a ride on the glass bottom boat. On the way to our next island, dolphins are often spotted. • Bartolomé Island @ Hike to the summit for a view worth the effort. Dinghy ride around colossal Pinnacle Rock, then enjoy the beach and snorkelling, possibly with Galápagos penguins, or ride in the glass-bottom boat.

DAY 6 • Prince Philip's Steps (Tower/Genovesa Island) @ A panga ride along the cliffs and then a steep climb up some stairs is followed by a walk to observe large colonies of Nazca boobies, red footed boobies, great frigate birds and storm petrels. Or continue the panga ride along the cliffs. • Darwin Bay (Tower/Genovesa Island) @ Hundreds of birds to see. Optional walk over uneven terrain for dramatic views, or return to the beach to enjoy swimming and snorkelling, or join us in a glass bottom boat ride.



DAY 7 • Puerto Baquerizo Moreno (San Cristóbal (Chatham) **Island)** @ Option to see the breeding programme of giant tortoises at Cerro Colorado. Flight back to the mainland. • Flight to Guayaquil @ Welcome and transfer to the hotel.

DAY 8 • Guayaquil Museum Tour @ Choose to visit two or three museums: the Municipal Museum; Museum Nahim Isaias Barquet; Museum of Anthropology and Contemporary Art (MAAC); Museum of Gold of the House of Culture. Enjoy an Ecuadorian style lunch.

DAY 9 • Catch your flight home.

The development of new routes for biking, trekking, birding, adventure racing, or just plain fun is what led our guides to find and open these hidden treasures for you to enjoy. Supported by space imaging, topographic maps, and GPS we can assure easy and safe navigation in these wonderful natural areas.

DAY 1 • Latitude 0° in the Pululahua Volcano. Walking: 5 hours. 11 km. 🚭 Home to a large diversity of birds including hummingbirds, mountain tanagers, eagles and hawks. At the top of the old crater rim, lunch is served at an archeological site – a solar calendar built 2000 years ago by the pre-Inca indigenous people known as the Yumbos. Breathtaking views of the valleys beneath.

DAY 2 • Cuicocha Crater Lake. Walking: 4 hours. 10 km. 👙 Find species such as Pumamaqui, Quishuar, chilca, bromarea, fushia, lupins, calcelaria, and colorful flowers. Stunning views to the lake and the Cotacachi, Mojanda and Imbabura volcanoes. Watch for mammals and birdlife such as the great Andean Condor. Visit a leather market and an indigenous bazaar filled with handmade items.

DAY 3 • Continental Divide to hot springs trek. Walking: 4 hours. 10.6 km. @ Drive to the Atlantic-Pacific continental divide. Hike through the Cayambe-Coca Reserve offering some of the best scenery in the country. Seek out three different species of deer, the elusive spectacled bear and birdlife on Amazon side. End this hike in the Papallacta hot springs and it's mineral-rich waters.

DAY 4 • Macaw Jungle Trail. Walking: 7.5 hours. 12 km. See Scenic drive to the Sumaco National Park, featuring the (active) Sumaco Volcano. At the Guacamayos (Macaw) range see spectacular views to the flatlands. See the cock-of-the-rock, toucans, caciques, oropendolas, manakins, military macaws and many unique species. Visit a Kichwa family that lives in the town of Archidona. Learn about the jungle life through the Waira Churis (Wind Dancers). Overnight at a river front jungle lodge.

DAY 5 • Rainforest walk & explore the Pastaza River Gorge. Walking: 2 hours. 3 km. @ Tropical lowland rainforest hike. Learn about the traditional use of plants for daily living and medicinal purposes. Visit a local Kichwa community. Climb back up through the Pastaza River Gorge. Continue to Baños de Agua Santa, on the slopes of the erupting Tungurahua volcano.

DAY 6 • Mysteries of the Llanganates. Walking: 4 to 5 hours. 10.7km. @ A great variety of birds and animals including hard-to-see species such as the spectacled bear are likely to be found on this hike with great views of the surrounding volcanoes. Descend into the Patate Valley through the ancient Panzaleo Trail. Overnight at La Cienega, a hacienda with 300 years of history.

CRUISING GALAPAGOS ISLANDS M/V SANTA CRUZ

Cruz. Welcome with lunch. • Las Bachas (Santa Cruz Island) @ After WWII, US military barges were abandoned here on the beach that has become known as "Bachas", now an important nesting area for the east Pacific green sea turtle. On the north shore enjoy a glorious white beach with several brackish lagoons which are the feeding grounds of various wading birds, from stilts to flamingos. This is a great opportunity to get acquainted with snorkelling gear and techniques.



Wednesday • Rábida Island (Jervis) @ Disembark on this red-coloured beach and stroll along the beach of this small island. Observe a large colony of sea lions, marine iguanas, mockingbirds, yellow warblers and several species of Darwin's finches. Close by is a salt pond where at times greater flamingos migrate. Snorkel from the beach to view underwater species and submarine landscapes, or enjoy a ride on the glass bottom boat. On the way to our next island, dolphins are often spotted. • Bartolomé Island 🥸 A moderately steep hike for a view from the summit is worth the effort. Dinghy ride around colossal Pinnacle Rock, then enjoy the beach and some snorkelling, possibly with Galápagos penguins, or else a ride in the glass-bottom boat for great views of the underwater world.

Thursday • Prince Philip's Steps (Tower/Genovesa Island) @ A panga ride along the cliffs and then disembark on rocks for a steep climb up some stairs followed by a walk of about a mile to the other side of this small island, observing large colonies of Nazca boobies, red footed boobies,

great frigate birds and storm petrels. Those not wishing to disembark can enjoy a longer panga ride along the cliffs. • Darwin Bay (Tower/Genovesa

Island) @ Hundreds of birds to see. Optional

Friday • Puerto Baquerizo Moreno (San Cristóbal (Chatham) Island) @ Optional departure to see the breeding programme of giant tortoises at Cerro Colorado. Airport




