Day 1 - Arrive in Lima

Arrive at Lima International Airport and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation.

Day 2 - Lima

Buffet breakfast. Morning at leisure. In the afternoon, experience sightseeing in the city of Lima and its attractions: *Plaza Mayor*, the *Government Palace*, the *Cathedral*, the *Archbishop's Palace*, the *City Hall* and the 17th-century church and cloister of *San Francisco*, world cultural heritage. Visit the modern residential suburb of *San Isidro* and the pre-Inca pyramid of *Huaca Huallamarca* and downtown *Miraflores*. Stop at *Park of Love* to enjoy a splendid view of the Pacific Ocean. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 3 - Lima • Cusco • Machu Picchu

Buffet breakfast. Transfer to Lima airport to take a flight to Cusco. Arrive and transfer to *Ollantaytambo* train station at *Sacred Valley* for a 1 hour and 30 minute trip in a *Vistadome* coach up to *Aguas Calientes* train station. Transfer to the hotel. Overnight at *Inti Inn Machupicchu Hotel* or similar.

Day 4 - Machu Picchu

Buffet breakfast. Transfer by bus to the top of the mountain and citadel of *Machu Picchu* for a 2 hour guided visit to the ruins of one of the most renowned examples of Inca architecture. Lost in history, it was not discovered until 1911 by the American explorer Hiram Bingham. Enjoy a self-service buffet lunch at a local restaurant. Return to the hotel in the afternoon. Overnight at *Machu Picchu*.

Day 5 - Machu Picchu • Cusco

Buffet breakfast. Morning to enjoy a second visit to the ruins on your own (bus tickets and entrance to *Machu Picchu* are included). By mid afternoon return by train to Cusco. At arrival, transfer to the hotel.

Day 6 - Cusco

Buffet breakfast. Morning at leisure. City tour of Cusco, the amazing colonial city built on the foundations of the Inca palaces. Visit the *Koricancha* or *Temple of the Sun* and appreciate the incredible masonry of the Incas; the *Plaza de Armas* and the carved woodwork, altars and paintings of the *Cathedral*. Visit the Inca fortress of *Sacsahuamán*, the underground cave and temple of *Kenko* and continue to *Tambomachay*, known as the *Baths of the Inca*. Overnight in Cusco.

Day 7 - Cusco • Puno

Buffet breakfast. Transfer to Cusco airport to take the flight to Juliaca. Arrive and transfer to Puno. On the way, take a guided visit to the famous pre-Inca tombs of *Sillustani*, located on the shores of the solitary *Umayo Lagoon*. These tombs or *Chullpas* with circular shaped towers were a cemetery for the religious leaders of *Tiawanacu* culture, almost 2000 years ago. Overnight at Puno.

Day 8 - Lake Titicaca

Buffet breakfast. Tour by boat on *Lake Titicaca*, the highest navigable lake in the world. Arrive at *Taquile Island* after a 3 hour boat trip and climb 600 stone steps to reach the hub of the island. Admire the views of the lake and its surrounding mountains. The people of Taquile are famous for their colourful, fine weavings and hospitality. On the way back to Puno, stop on *Uros Island*, built on layers of the totora reeds – hence the name *floating island*, to understand the Uros Indians way of living and their traditions kept for generations by seeking out a living through fishing and selling handicrafts. A box lunch will be enjoyed during the tour. Overnight at Puno.

Day 9 - Juliaca • Lima

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Juliaca Airport and depart for

Day 1 - Arrive in Quito

Arrival at Quito airport. Transfer to the hotel. Accommodation: superior category. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

Day 2 - Quito

Breakfast at hotel. Visit downtown Quito and its treasures of art and architecture. Enjoy the colonial quarter, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. From the *Independence Plaza* stroll to the *Monastery of San Francisco*, one the of great religious buildings of the New World. Continue to the centre of the world, the *Equatorial Monument* (latitude 0°) and receive a certificate for having crossed the Equator. Visit the *Ethnographic Museum*, showing the different Native American groups living in Ecuador. Return to the hotel. Afternoon at leisure. Evening departure for *Panoramic Quito by Night* tour and enjoy a leisurely dinner at one of the city's finest restaurants.

Day 3 – Quito • Galapagos

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to the airport to get a flight to *Galapagos Island*. Arrive at *Baltra Island* and transfer to board cruise ship *M/V Santa Cruz*. Cabin assignment, lunch, and ship's boat drill. *Las Bachas* (Santa Cruz Island) also known as barges beach as US military barges were abandoned here. Now a nesting area for the east Pacific green sea turtle, it is a glorious white beach (wet landing), with several brackish lagoons which are the feeding grounds of various wading birds, from stilts to flamingos. Get acquainted with snorkelling gear and techniques. Welcome cocktail at arrival and dinner.

Day 4 - Galapagos • James Island

After breakfast, explore the cliffs and learn about the history of *Santiago Island*, the whalers, pirates and Darwin's epic voyage in 1835. The cove is home to a large number of marine birds, sea lions, and organisms. Enjoy fantastic natural formations: the *Elephant Rock, The Bishop* and an impressive natural cave; great for snorkelling! Lunch on board. *Puerto Egas* (James Island): Wet landing for a mid-length walk and to view land and marine birds, marine iguanas and a colony of fur-sea lions; snorkeling and swimming.

Day 5 - Galapagos Islands

Rábida Island (Jervis): Wet landing and stroll on the red beach of this small island. Observe a large colony of sea lions, marine iguanas, mockingbirds, yellow warblers and several species of Darwin's finches. Find a hidden salt pond where, at times, greater flamingos migrate. Snorkel or ride on the glass bottom boat. Lunch on board. Dry landing at Bartolomé Island for a moderate hike to the summit and enjoy the view. Dinghy ride around colossal Pinnacle Rock and time to enjoy the beach and snorkeling, possibly with Galápagos penguins, or ride on the glass-bottom boat. Dinner.

Day 6 - Galapagos Islands

Prince Philip's Steps (Tower/Genovesa Island): Panga ride along the cliffs. Disembark for a 90 foot stair climb to a stimulating 1 mile walk to the other side of the island. Observe colonies of Nazca and red footed boobies, frigate birds and storm petrels or enjoy a longer Panga ride, depending on weather. Lunch on board. Darwin Bay (Tower/Genovesa Island): Wet landing. An easy stroll observing hundreds of birds, red footed and Nazca boobies, gulls, herons, finches and mockingbirds. Optional: walk over sharp lava and uneven terrain for spectacular views; return to the beach to swim and snorkel at this natural harbor; or join the glass bottom boat ride. Farewell cocktail, departure brief and dinner.

Day 7 - Galapagos Islands • Guayaquil

Breakfast. Optional: see the giant tortoises breeding program at *Cerro Colorado*, 45 minutes by bus on *San Cristóbal Island*. Return to town and transfer to the airport to fly to the mainland and then to *Guayaquil*. (Flights not included). Welcome and assistance at *Guayaquil* airport and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation: superior category.

Day 8 - Guayaquil

Breakfast at hotel. Depart for *Guayaquil Museum Tour* to experience the history of the city and art. 



Day 1 – Arrive in Buenos Aires

Arrive at Buenos Aires airport and transfer to your hotel.

Day 2 - Buenos Aires

Breakfast at hotel. Get acquainted with Buenos Aires during a half-day tour highlighting the city's major neighborhoods and attractions. 

Day 1 - Arrive in Santiago de Chile

Arrive at Santiago de Chile airport, assistance and transfer to the hotel.

Day 2 - Santiago de Chile

Breakfast at hotel. Experience a half-day panoramic tour of the city, from the history of the colonial neighborhoods to the modernity of Sanhattan, through the different sceneries that characterize this Southamerican metropolis. Visit the city's old residential area; Barrio Universitario (University Area); the historical and financial City Center; La Moneda Government Palace; the Main Square; the green Parque Forestal and the bohemian Bellavista neighborhood. Admire the stunning building that houses the Fine Arts Museum and visit Cerro San Cristóbal for a unique view of the city. Return to the hotel.

Day 3 - Santiago • Valparaiso

Breakfast at hotel. Depart to the coast by Route 68, which connects Santiago with the port of Valparaíso in only 1 1/2 hours, crossing the *Curacavi Valley*, with its vineyards and little fruit markets; and *Casablanca Valley*, a wine making area with a captivating green landscape. Arrive at the magical port of Valparaiso, a World Heritage Site and admire the view from the hills. Through walkways and terraces, be witness to the wonderful natural amphitheater that frames the bay and enjoy the history of this port-city. Experience the old funiculars that made this picturesque city famous. After visiting the unique Valparaiso, head to Viña del Mar city and visit its beaches and main attractions. Return to Santiago. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 4 - Santiago • Easter Island

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to the airport to take a flight to *Easter Island*. Arrival, assistance and transfer to the hotel.

Day 5 - Easter Island

Breakfast at hotel. Half-day tour to the restored *Ahu Akivi* with its 7 *Moais* in the middle of the island. Proceed to the *Ana Te Pahu Cave*, one of the biggest lava tubes of the island before a visit to *Ahu Tepeu* (not restored) and to the top notch quarry *Puna Pau*. Return to the hotel. In the afternoon, transfer to the extinct volcano *Rano Kau* for a view over the whole island with its distinct geological features. Experience a breathtaking view of the crater lake on top of the volcano. Continue to the ceremonial village of *Orongo*, where the birdman competition took place, and see the spectacular petroglyphs related to this culture and the 3 islands situated opposite the coast. Return to *Ahu Vinapu* and visit *Ana Kai Tangata* cave with its paintings. Return to the hotel.

Day 6 - Easter Island

Breakfast at hotel. Experience a full-day excursion to the lost culture of *Rapa Nui* in a unique tour of the south coast to visit representative examples of the (not restored) platforms, *Ahus Vaihu* and *Akahanga*. Stop at *Rano Raraku*, the quarry of almost 900 stone statues, 397 of them still lying or standing at the slopes of the extinct volcano with a crater lake. Visit *Ahu Tongariki*, the most recent and biggest restoration on the island with 15 *Moais* restored. Continue to the east coast and visit *Ahu Te Pito Kura* and the *Navel of the World*. Stop at the beach of *Anakena* with its recovered *Ahus Nau Nau* and *Ature Huke* and enjoy the warm Pacific Ocean. Return to the hotel.

Day 7 - Easter Island • Santiago • Onwards





This 11-day expedition provides the ideal trip to the great white continent. With departure and return from Ushuaia, provincial capital of Tierra del Fuego, Argentina, you will make an exciting crossing of the legendary *Drake Passage* to arrive in the *South Shetland Islands* and the *Antarctic Peninsula*. From the waters of Patagonia to the gateway of the spectacular landscape of fjords, glaciers and icebergs, the *M/V Antarctic Dream* will transport you in a comfortable environment, full of on-board entertainment, hotel and dinning services and, above all, under the attentive care of the crew.

Day 1 - Ushuaia

Passengers board the *M/V Antarctic Dream*. Greeting by our Expedition Leader and staff. Check-in begins at 2:30 pm on departure day. Lunch and dinner included.

Day 2 & 3 – Drake Passage

Wandering albatrosses, storm petrels and other seabirds will escort the vessel as you sail south across the *Drake Passage*, named to honour Sir Francis Drake, the 16th-century English navigator. Continue towards the *Antarctic Convergence*, a biological barrier where cold polar waters sink beneath the warmer waters of the more temperate zone. In 1819, the British explorer William Smith described the *South Shetland Islands* as "barren and covered with snow, with seals in abundance". Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.

Day 4 to 8 – Antarctica Peninsula

Experience the magnificent scenery of mountains, snow and ice and a wide variety of the native wildlife such as the blue-eyed shags, gulls, cape petrels, skuas, snowy sheathbills and Antarctic terns. Marine mammals may be spotted at close range, including Weddell crab-eaters, leopard seals, orcas, humpback and mink whales.

The program includes a first landing on the *White Continent* (Neko Bay) discovered by Adrian de Gerlache, a Belgian explorer; and a second, on *Port Lockroy* (Gaudier Island), close to *Wiencke Island* in the *Antarctic Peninsula* and principle base of the 1944 *Tabarin Operation* for scientific research such as the Antarctic's first ionosphere measurements and the first recording of an atmospheric whistle. Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.

Day 9 & 10 - Drake Passage

Leave the Antarctic and head north back across the *Drake Passage*. Live the unique experience of swimming in *Whaler's Bay* and *Pendulum Cove*. In the afternoon, disembark at *Hannah Point* (Livingstone Island), one of the best places in the Antarctic to see fauna: Chinstrap and Gentoo penguins, giant petrels, Wilson petrels, skuas and blue-eyed shags. With luck, you should also spot sea elephants. Enjoy the way back to Ushuaia comparing and revising notes, photos, and dwell upon the past weeks adventures. Take in the final lectures and enjoy the delicious gastronomy on board.

Day 11 - Ushuaia

Land at 9:00 am after an early breakfast. Thus ends an incredible and unique expedition.

Day 1 – Arrive in Rio de Janeiro

Arrive at Rio de Janeiro International airport. Welcome and transfer to your hotel, located in *Leme* – a quiet area only 20 yards from famous *Copacabana beach*, close to restaurants, shopping centers and many attractions. 

Day 1 - Arrive in Colonia

Arrive in Colonia Del Sacramento and transfer to Plaza Mayor Hotel located in the Old Town of the city. Walking city tour along the cobbled streets of the Old Town; visit the buildings, old forts and Spanish and Portuguese Museums and the most important attractions of this Old Portuguese City from the 17th-century, declared Patrimony of Mankind by the UNESCO.

Day 2 - Colonia • Montevideo

After breakfast, transfer to the bus station to board a regular bus to Montevideo. On arrival private transfer to the *NH Hotel* in Montevideo. City tour with lunch at the lively *Port Market* (included).

Day 3 – Montevideo • Punta Del Este Summer Resort • Guardia Del Monte

Morning: enjoy a wine tour to the best vineyards of Montevideo with tasting included. After a delicious lunch at one of the vineyards, continue to Punta del Este to enjoy a tour of Juan Gorlero (the main avenue), the yacht's port, the Golf, San Rafael, Rincón del Indio and Cantegril residential areas and the lovely Casapueblo, a strange and attractive construction designed by the famous Uruguayan artist Carlos Páez Vilaró. Cross the undulated bridge of La Barra and then continue the journey towards Guardia del Monte, a working estancia next to the Laguna de Castillos. Guardia del Monte's outstanding landscape beauty also has important ecosystems such as wetlands, with a great variety of birds, and native scrublands. This area has been declared a Natural Animal Reserve since 1996. Visit the forest of Ombúes, possibly the only one in the world as the Ombú rarely grows in groups of more than 2 or 3. Each tree has its own wonderful shape with thick, twisting roots spreading out over the ground; some are over 500 years old and have a diameter of 2 meters (6 feet). Dinner and accommodation at Charabon (full board included).

Day 4 - Estancia Guardia Del Monte

After breakfast, ride to the *Palm Forests*; despite a number of stories, no one knows how the palm trees got here – some 300 years old; they are not native but they give the landscape a very exotic look. In the afternoon, enjoy some of the gaucho lifestyle and participate in the rural activities of the day or just enjoy some bird watching. This estancia has a large area of marshlands and wetlands, both of which are teeming with bird life (more than 400 species), making another varied ride and giving the chance to see the graceful black-necked swan (largest populations in the world found here), the rare white goose and many ducks and other birds such as the largest bird in South America – the 'ostrich-like' ñandú (rhea). Otters, coypus and capybaras inhabit the marshlands and streams. At several points on

the trip, see the pink flamingo – a species of flamingo with very bright pink pigment quite common in Uruguay. Dinner and accommodation at *Guardia del Monte*.

Day 5 – Cabo Polonio • La Pedrera

After breakfast, private transfer to the *Valizas Village*, where a local guide will be waiting to start an unforgettable tour to *Cabo Polonio Village*. Enjoy a boat tour along the *Valizas Stream* towards the small town of the *Rincon* where you will be guided to the private houses of some craftsmen — a lovely experience to meet the locals! From this point, the trekking starts toward the incredible mobile sand dunes to the *Buena Vista Hill* and a fantastic view of the ocean. Trek or ride to the village. Lunch at a seaside restaurant where local fresh sea food is served! Visit the lighthouse and sea lion reserve (the biggest one in the world) and drive 4x4 crossing the dunes and beach to the entrance of the village. Private transfer to La Pedrera, a lovely small town on the emerald coast of Uruguay. Accommodation at *Pueblo Barrncas Eco Lodge*.

Day 6 - La Pedrera

Day at leisure. La Pedrera is located on the South Atlantic coast, 230 km east of Montevideo. The geological rock formations on this part of the coast and the particular location of La Pedrera give it the reputation of being the perfect balcony to watch the big ocean. Also known for its casual atmosphere, La Pedrera is the kind of place where time flows freely. Sleep when you need it, eat when you are hungry and dress comfortably all the time. Peace and quiet is legendary in La Pedrera; restaurants and pubs are open late allowing for enjoyable evenings for couples or friends.

Day 1 – Arrive in Santa Cruz

Airport reception, hotel transfer. Afternoon city tour. On the eastern tropical plains, Santa Cruz is well-known for colonial and modern architecture. Unusual animals and exotic birds can be seen at the zoo.

Day 2 – Santa Cruz • Samaipata ruins • Santa Cruz

Full-day visit to *Tarabuco's Market* (Sundays only) or a day at leisure. On Sunday Tarabuco becomes a kaleidoscope of colours, Indian costumes and the bustling local market. The natives here still use leather helmets similar to that of the Conquistadores. Continue to the *Candelaria Hacienda*. Enjoy lunch and the dance of *Pujllay*, the most authentic of Bolivian dances. Return to Sucre late afternoon.

Day 5 - Sucre • Potosi

A 3 hour drive to Potosi, the famous Colonial city and main source of silver during Spanish colonial times. The mountain towers over the city and, according to legend, has produced enough to build a solid silver bridge from Potosi to Madrid Spain! Visit the *Cathedral*, the church of *San Francisco* and the *Casa de la Moneda* (Royal Mint) with its wooden machinery used to make the silver coins for Spain.

Day 6 - Uyuni






