DAY 1 (NOV 27/FRI): LIMA | INC: -/-/D

Arrival in Lima (CM 493 at 19.27hrs), meet and greet at the airport, to the hotel. By night we will enjoy a welcome dinner at restaurant Huaca Pucllana. Overnight stay in Lima.

DAY 2 (NOV 28/SAT): LIMA – CUSCO – SACRED VALLEY | INC: B/L

Transfer to the airport to catch our flight to Cusco (LA 2023 – 08.00/09.20hrs). Upon arriving, you will be welcomed by one of our representatives, who will assist you and give you a short briefing about the rest of your stay. As you begin the journey toward Valle Sagrado (Sacred Valley), you will enjoy the beauty of the Andean landscape along the way. Brief stop to visit Awanakancha, a tourist complex where we will see and feed the Andean camelids such as the llamas and alpacas, and where the locals will show us the weaving and dyeing techniques of their traditional textiles. We will then continue to Inca and Colonial Pisac. Discover one of the most beautiful archeological sites in the Sacred Valley at the top of the mountain where you can have a view of the colonial town of Pisac. Walking tour to the Colonial town. Time to do some shopping at the handicraft market. Then, we will head to the impressive Inkariy Museum. Here we will enjoy a delicious lunch. We will take a guided tour of the museum to learn more about the numerous rooms where cultural representations of pre-Hispanic civilizations of ancient Peru are exhibited. Overnight in the Sacred Valley.

DAY 3 (NOV 29/SUN): SACRED VALLEY - MACHU PICCHU | INC: B/L/D

Our adventure journey takes us now to less explored treasures of the Sacred Valley of the Incas. First stop: Moray, a place with breathtaking views thanks to its colossal concentric terraces resembling a coliseum. What did they use it for? The terraces recreated 20 different types of microclimates, and they were studied to ensure the agricultural production of the empire. We will continue our journey to Maras, the millenary colonial salt mines. The contrast of the white pools against the green valley is so impressive that it resembles a postcard. Buffet lunch. In the afternoon, we will head towards the archaeological complex of Ollantaytambo, where you can see the technique with which the Incas work the stone. It is now time to catch the train at the Ollantaytambo station. We will arrive in Aguas Calientes where our trained staff will welcome and assist us on getting settled in one of the hotels in Aguas Calientes (now, Machu Picchu town). Dinner included at hotel.

DAY 4 (NOV 30/MON): MACHU PICCHU - CUSCO | INC: B/L

We will board the bus to go up the winding road to Machu Picchu, amid a spectacular view of the Urubamba River and its canyon. The Lost City of the Incas, Machu Picchu, will astonish us with its terraces, ceremonial shrines, steps and urban areas. Energy is all around us. After a guided visit, we will have lunch at one of the restaurants in the area. At the arranged time, we will return to Cusco and will be transferred to the hotel. Overnight stay in Cusco.

DAY 5 (DEC 01/TUE): CUSCO - PUNO | INC: B/L

Departure on a private bus to Puno. On the way we'll stop to visit the attractions this beautiful route has to offer. The first stop: Andahuaylillas for a visit to its beautiful chapel, then its Racchi, Temple of the Wiracocha god where the walls and narrow streets stand out. Then it's lunch time and the opportunity to see the view at La Raya, natural border between Cusco and Puno. We will arrive in Puno in the early afternoon and immediately be transferred to the pier for a boat trip to visit the "people of the lake": The Uros and their handmade islands. It is hard to believe













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but these friendly locals live, get an education and make a living on these floating islands. Return to the hotel. Overnight stay in Puno.

DAY 6 (DEC 02/WED): PUNO - JULIACA - LIMA | INC: B/L/D

In the morning, we will go to the airport in Juliaca to board the flight back to Lima (LA 2121 - 08.20/10.00hrs).

On arrival in Lima, welcoming reception and immediate transfer to a local restaurant for lunch. After lunch, our tour of the city starts.

We will drive along the main streets, plazas and avenues of the city. We will start at the Lovers Park in Miraflores with a spectacular view of the Pacific Ocean. Then, we will have a panoramic view of Huaca Pucliana, a ceremonial center the ancient Lima culture; and in San Isidro, the financial center of the city, we will see Huaca Huallamarca, an ancient pre-Inca shrine. We will then continue to the Main Square, where we will find the Government Palace and the City Hall. We will visit the Cathedral and explore the Santo Domingo Convent, along which corridors San Martin de Porras and San Rosa de Lima used to walk around in 17th century, and where their remains rest today. Finally, the Larco Museum will be awaiting us. This is a mansion built on top of a pre-Columbian pyramid of the 7th century. There we will find treasures that have been exhibited in the most prestigious museums of the world and it is organized according to techniques. The storeroom and the unique display of erotic pottery of pre-Columbian times are the highlights.

At the end, we will be able to enjoy an exquisite farewell dinner in a magical and cozy atmosphere with a view to the beautiful gardens. Overnight stay in Lima.

DAY 7 (DEC 03/THU): LIMA | INC: B

Departure transfer (CM 760 at 13.38hrs).
